INTERIM PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear NPC Family,

Grace and peace to you! As we anticipate our Ash Wednesday Service (7:00pm on March 5th) and the season of Lent, I'd like to focus my comments on a couple of topics.

First, during the five Wednesdays of Lent that follow Ash Wednesday (beginning on March 12th,) I will be teaching a bible study on the Cross of Christ. We will look at a number of the key biblical passages that paint for us the portrait of this central reality of the Gospel, namely, that through the Cross of Christ God reconciled the world to himself and remedied the rayages of sin. This subject is profound and mysterious, yet spiritually deeply encouraging to those to contemplate it. I would love to have you be a part of our gathering. No prior bible study experience is assumed.

The class will start at 7pm following our Community Night meal at 6:00. The meal is a wonderful time of table fellowship and I encourage you to join us for it as well. And kids are welcome for the meal and the class time! In fact Trisha Wirta will be

providing a children's program during our bible study. (Please call Pam in the church office if your children will be attending.)

Second, just like Lent leads to Easter, and Advent leads to Christmas, so too NPC's current interim season will lead to the arrival of your new pastor. With one big difference: we know when Easter and Christmas are...we don't know when the new pastor will arrive! But lots of folks are doing highquality behind the scenes work to make sure the whole interim process is done as well and as thoroughly as possible to ensure the very best outcome. The Interim Teams (Mission/ Vision, Organization, 125th Anniversary, Pastoral Care) each have developed strategies to accomplish their tasks in a timely fashion. Please pray for them and actively participate as opportunities arise. You will be hearing more from these groups in the following couple of months.
